Bloom Buddies

In this 1-hour workshop, participants will learn the basics of flower arranging, floral care, and the origins of the blooms they're using — all while expressing their creativity.

What's Included:

- A petite glass bud vase with enriched water
- A handful of fresh in-season flowers
- Decorative ribbon to personalize their creation
- All tools and materials provided

The Botanist

In this exciting 1-hour class, students will learn the process of capillary action—the mechanism by which flowers absorb water—in a hands-on activity that integrates botanical science and creativity. Using dyed floral water, each student will create a mini arrangement to observe how flowers absorb and display color over time.

What's Included:

- A glass bud vase with dyed & enriched water
- White fresh flowers
- Decorative ribbon to personalize their creation
- All tools and materials provided

Build-a-Bouquet

In this creative 1-hour class, students will design and wrap their own hand-tied bouquet while learning about the historical and cultural origins of each bloom, flower sourcing, basic flower care, and essential styling techniques. Each participant will take home a beautifully arranged bouquet wrapped in floral paper and tied with ribbon.

What's Included:

- Floral paper & satin ribbon
- Fresh flowers & greens (varieties vary by week)
- All tools and materials provided

Floral Styling

In this 1.5-hour hands-on class, students will create a small-to-medium vase arrangement and learn the fundamentals of floral design. The workshop covers flower sourcing, preparation, basic styling principles, and floral nutrition for long-lasting care.
